CO-ED YOUTH SOCCER CAMP (41010)

Classes will meet regardless of the weather, however we will not go in the water in excessive wind or under the threat of a thunderstorm. Requirements: ability to swim and tread water, closed toed shoes must be worn at all times. CSC will provide life jackets that will be worn at all times on the water. Enrollment limit - 16 participants per session.
